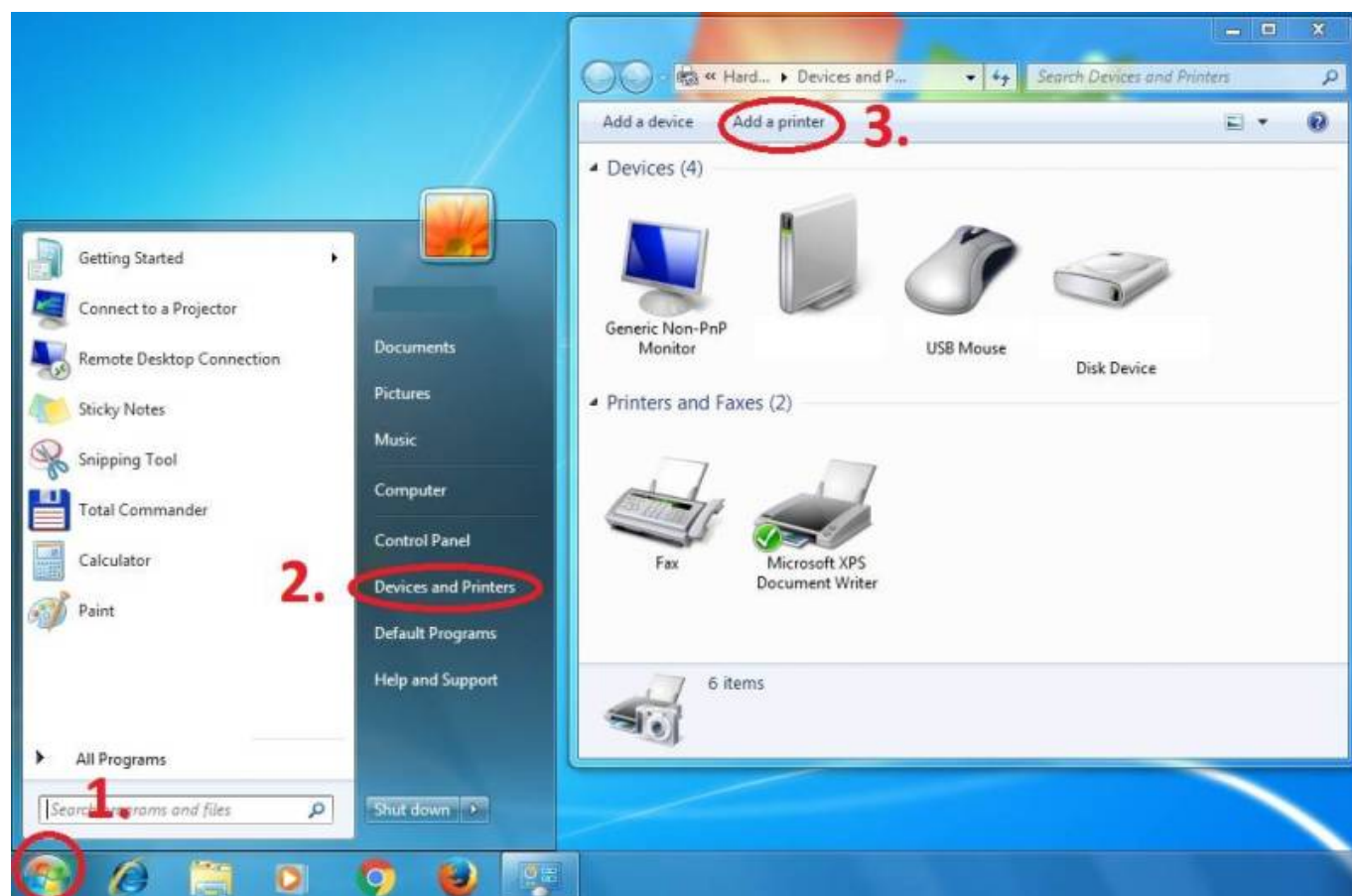


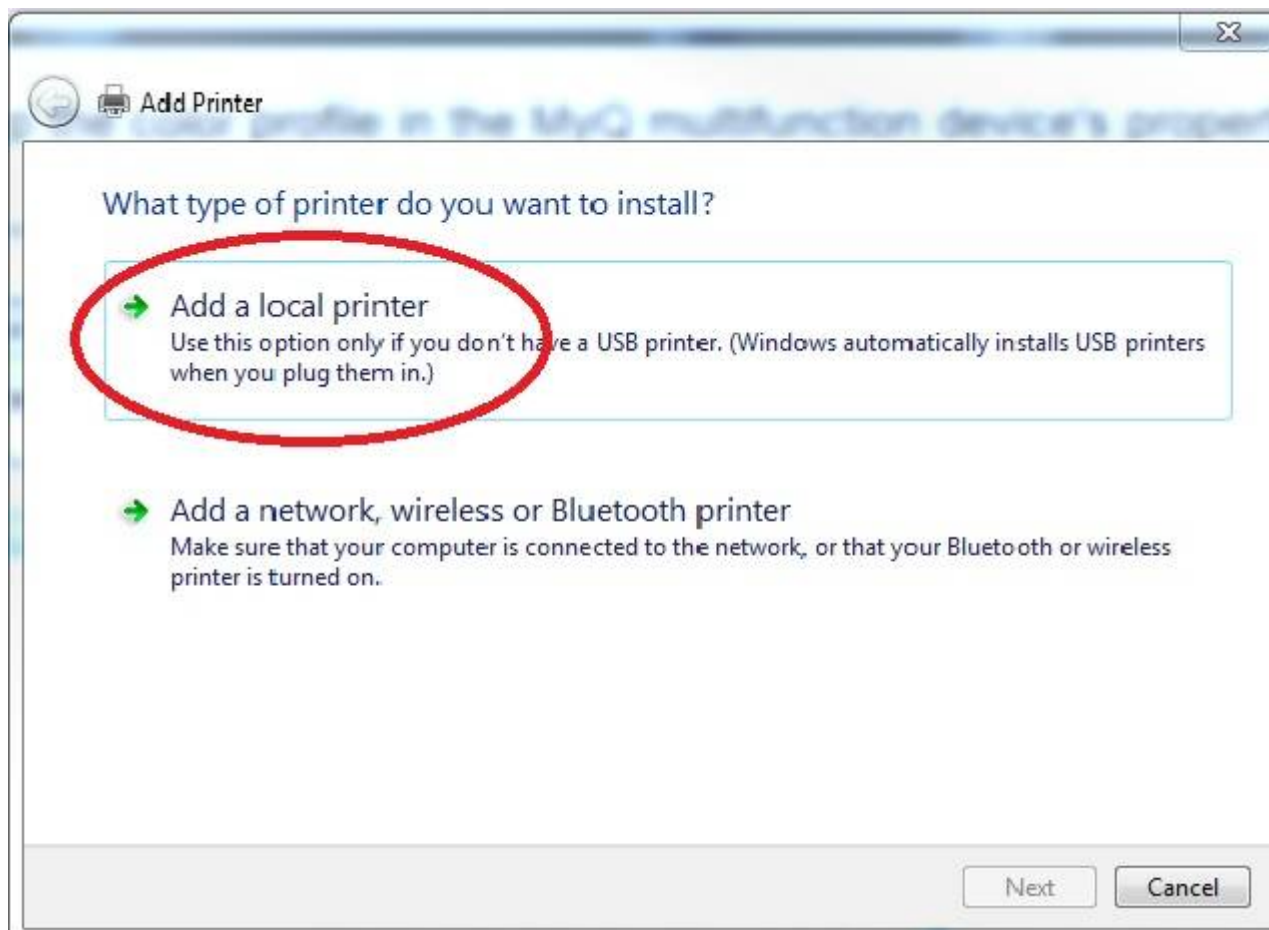
# Instructions for adding a Kyocera printer to user stations

**Important: notebook must be connected to WiFi residents !!!** (libairfree WiFi is not supported)

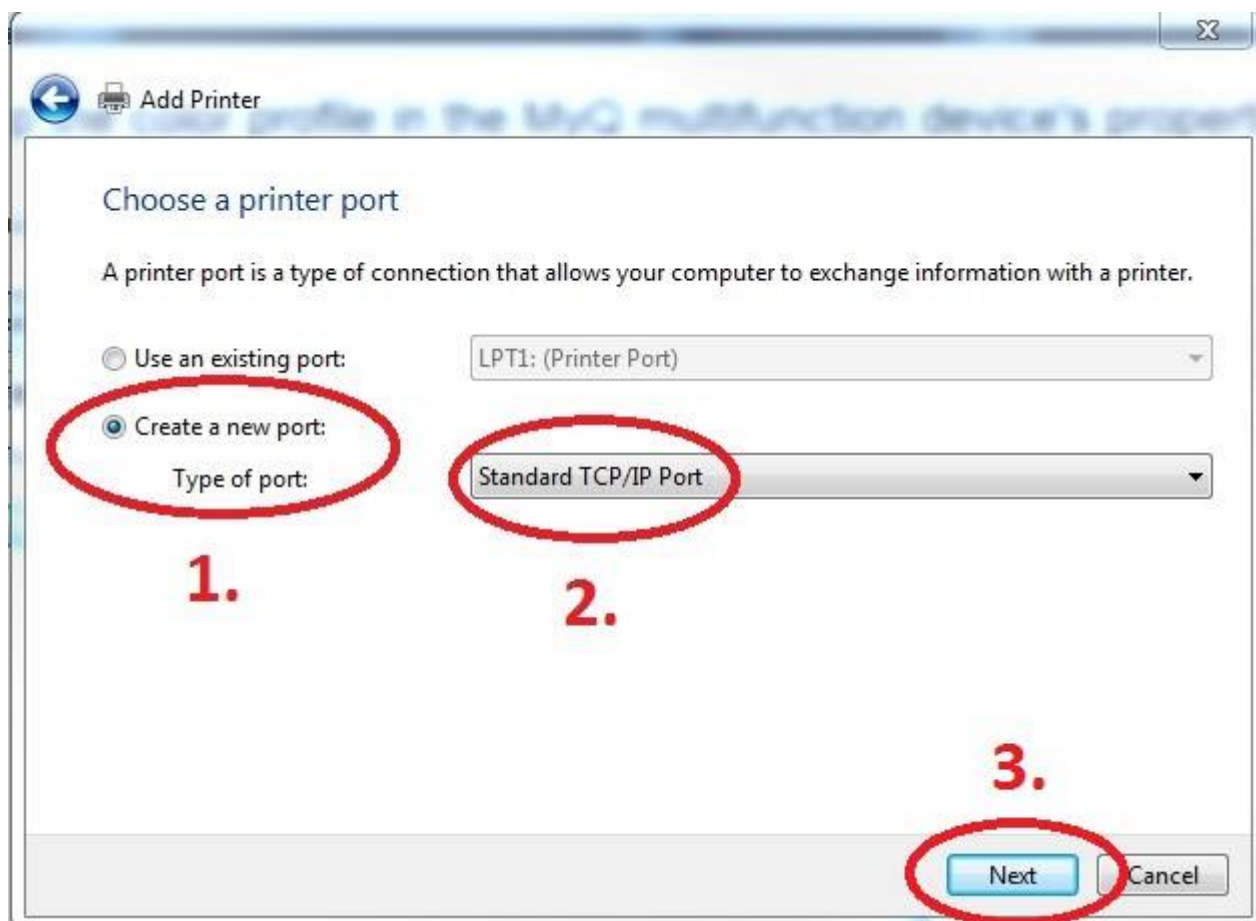
**Press Start button→ Devices and Printers → Add a Printer**




**Add a local printer**

## Enter Hostname - myq.cerge-ei.cz



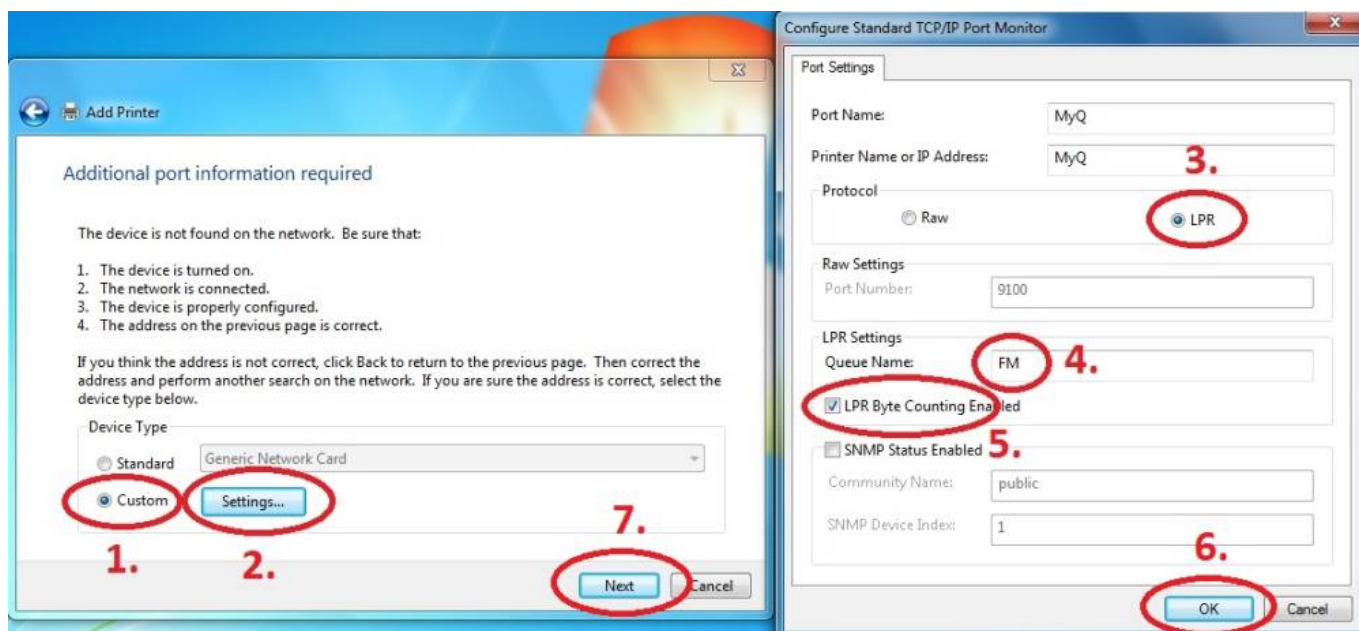
## Customize Settings

Important settings (check twice)

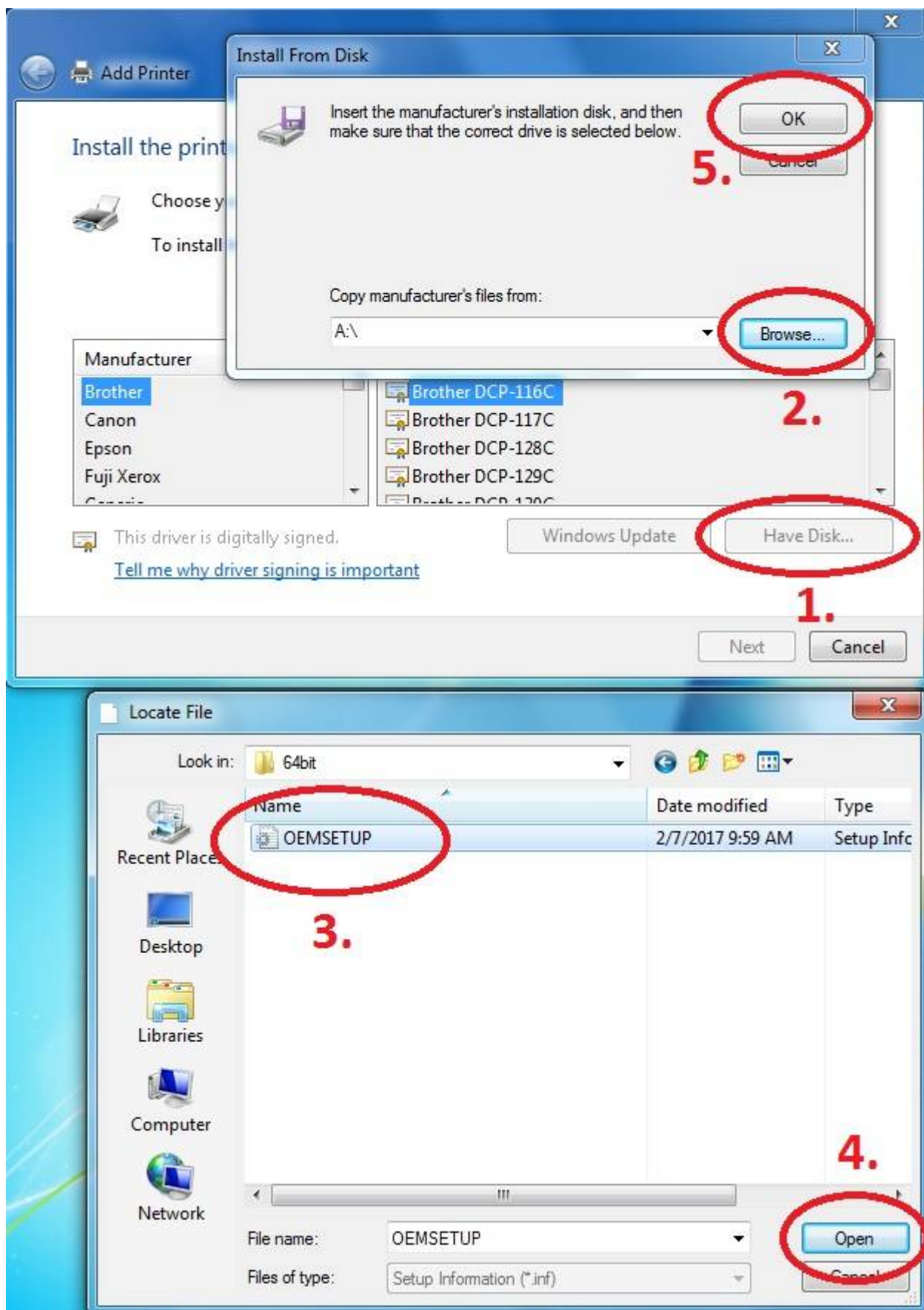


- Protocol: **LPR (LPD)**
- Queue name: **FM**
- [x] **LPR Byte Counting Enabled**

Queue link: `lpd:myq.cerge-ei.cz/FM`



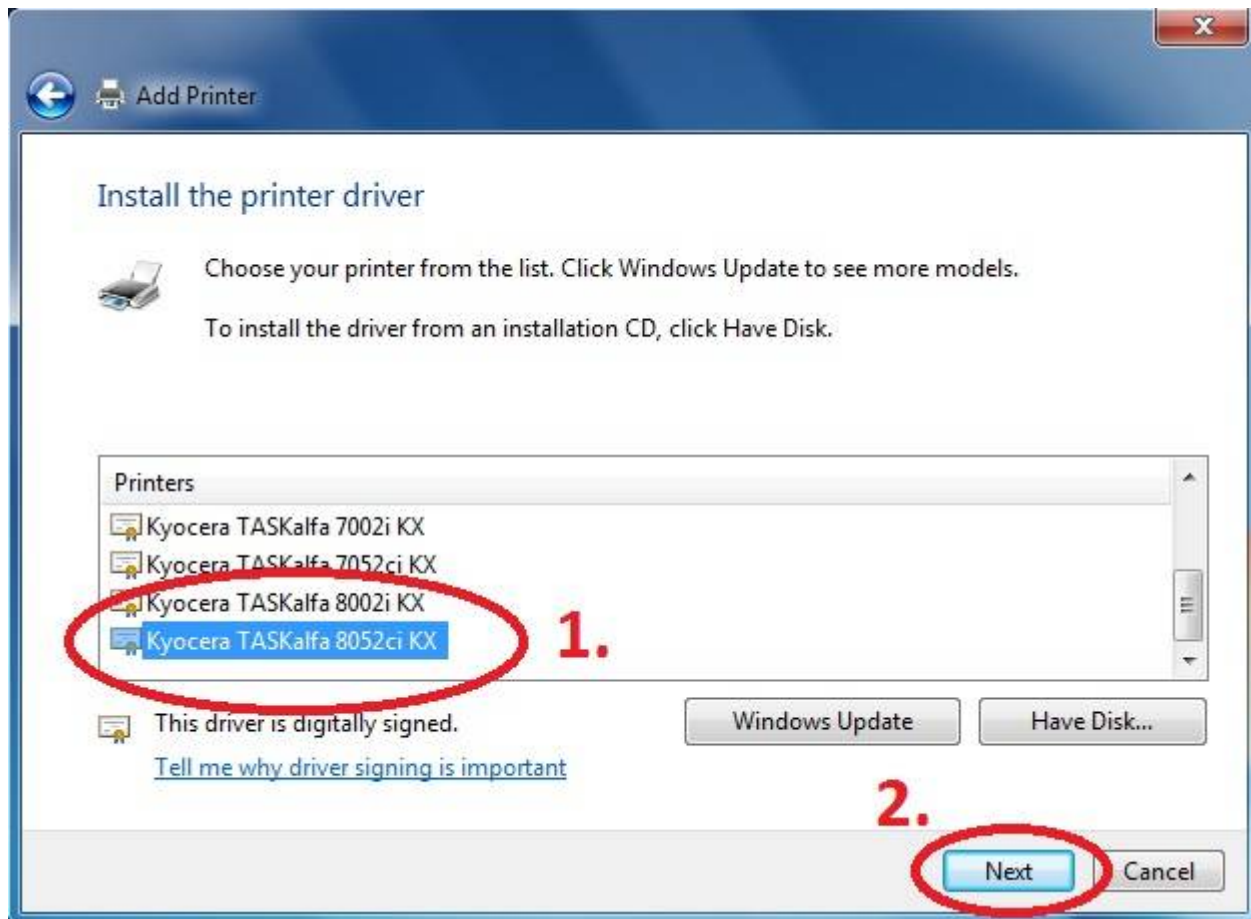
Download driver and unzip it to the local folder (for example c:\driver\).  
Choose 32-bit or 64-bit version depending on your system: - 32-bit driver- 64-bit driver  
Mac OS: OS X 10.8 - 10.13Mac OS X 10.5 and newer\*\*Press Have Disk...  
Navigate to the driver folder (for example c:\driver\64-bit\) and select "OEMSETUP".

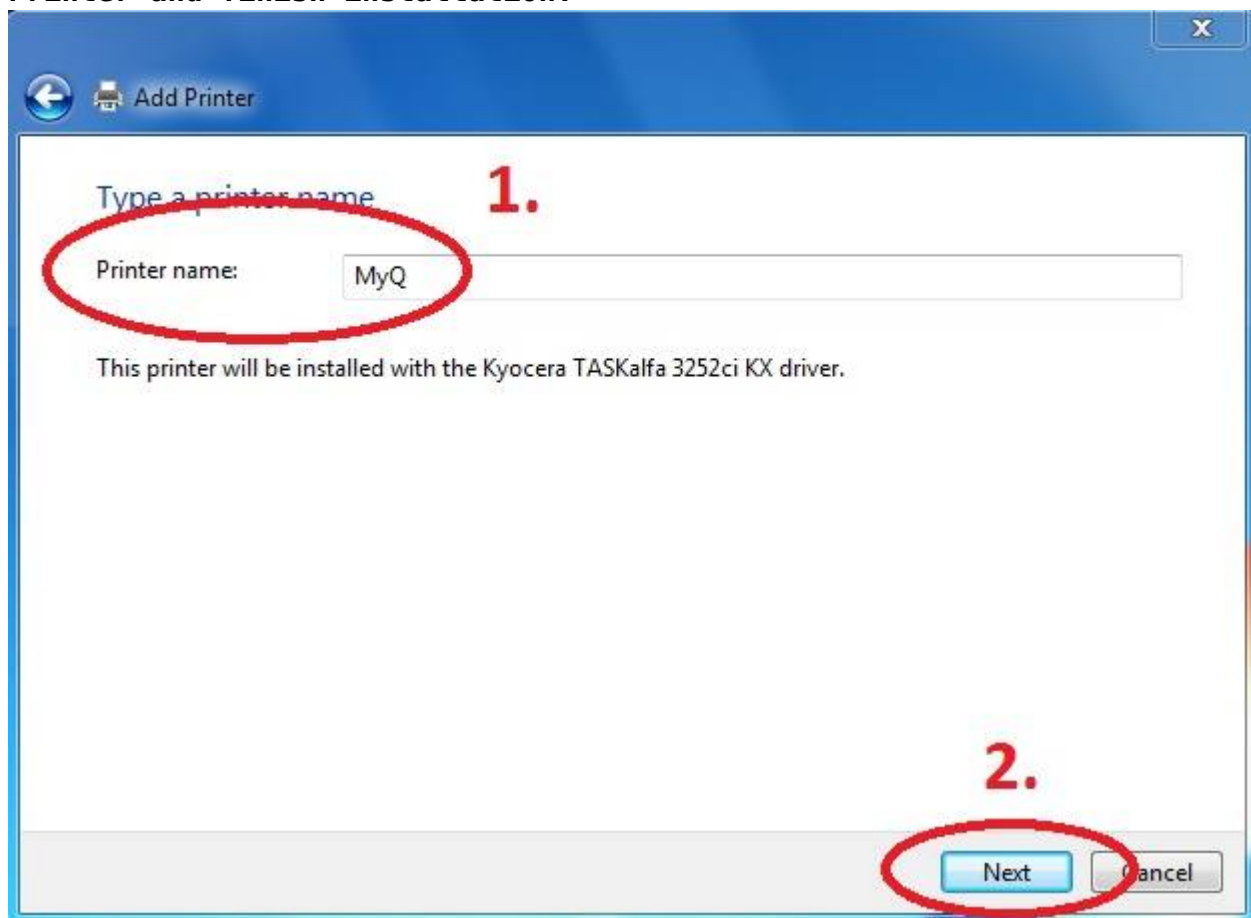
