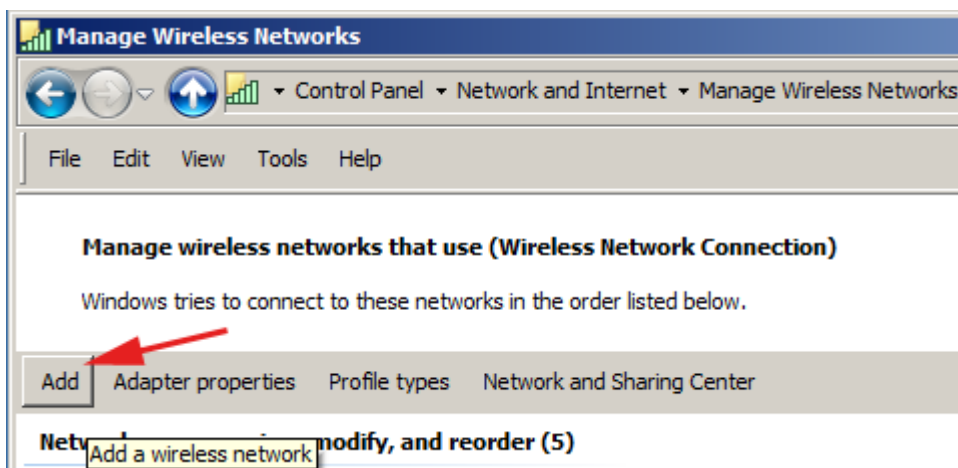
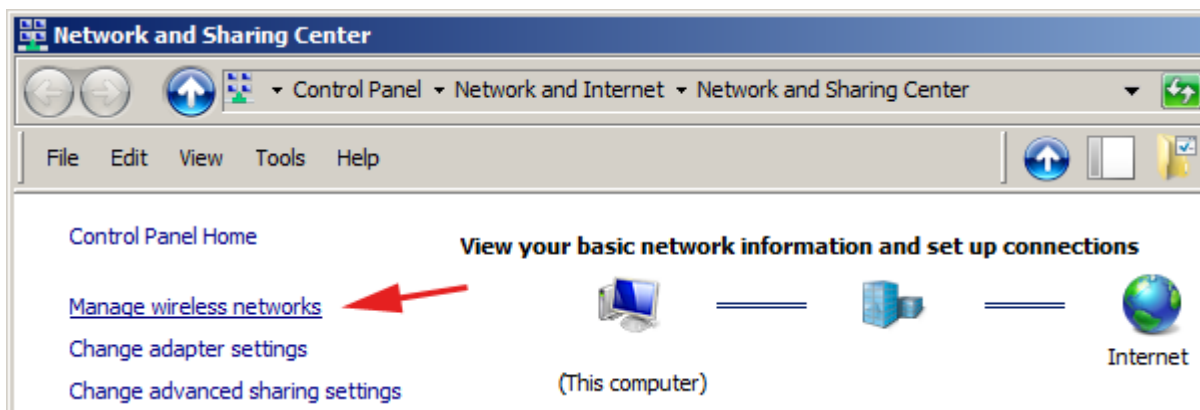
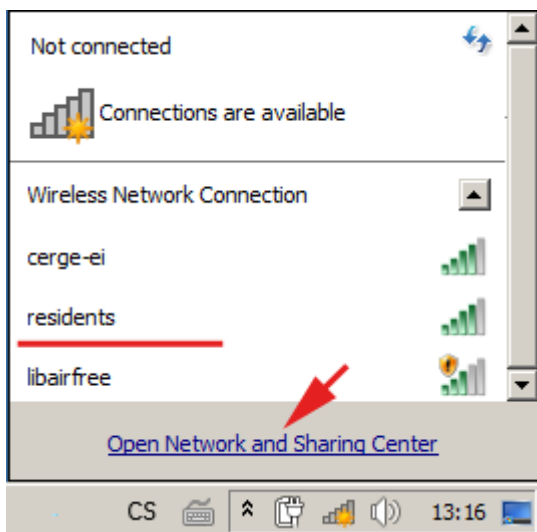
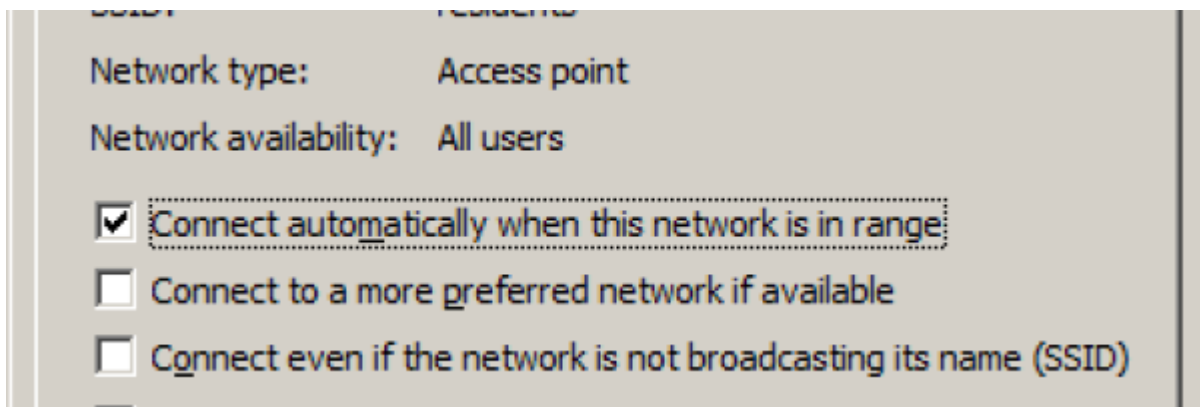
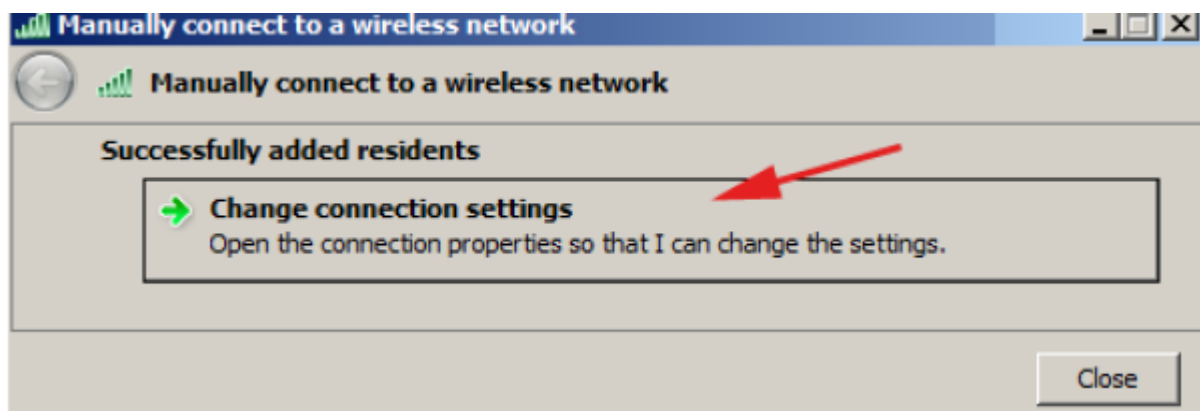
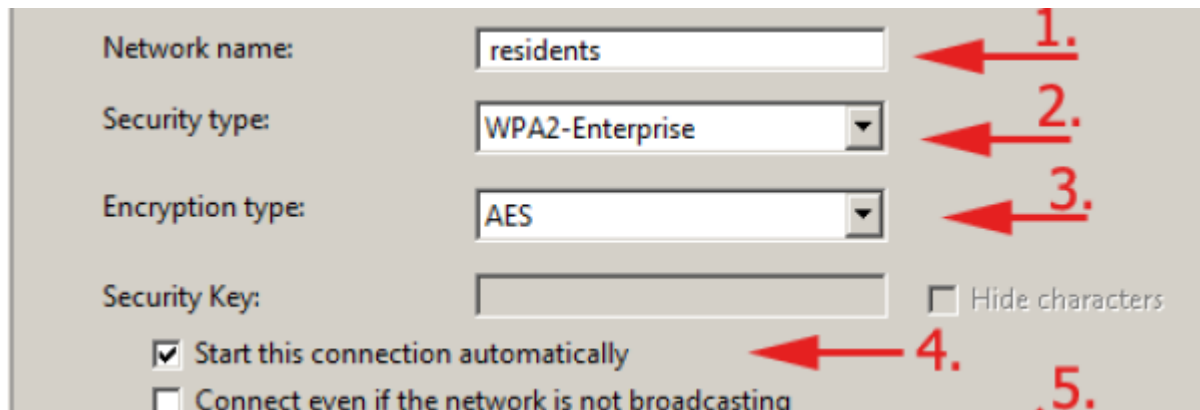
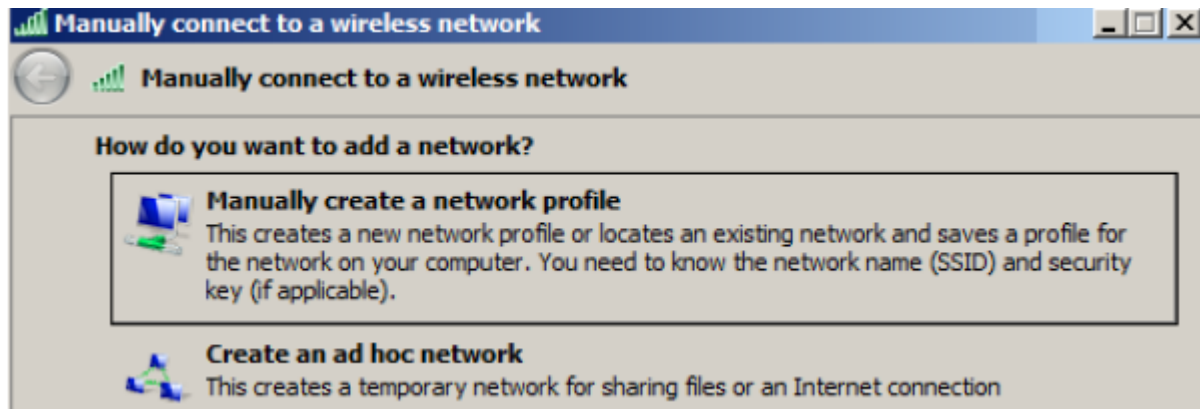
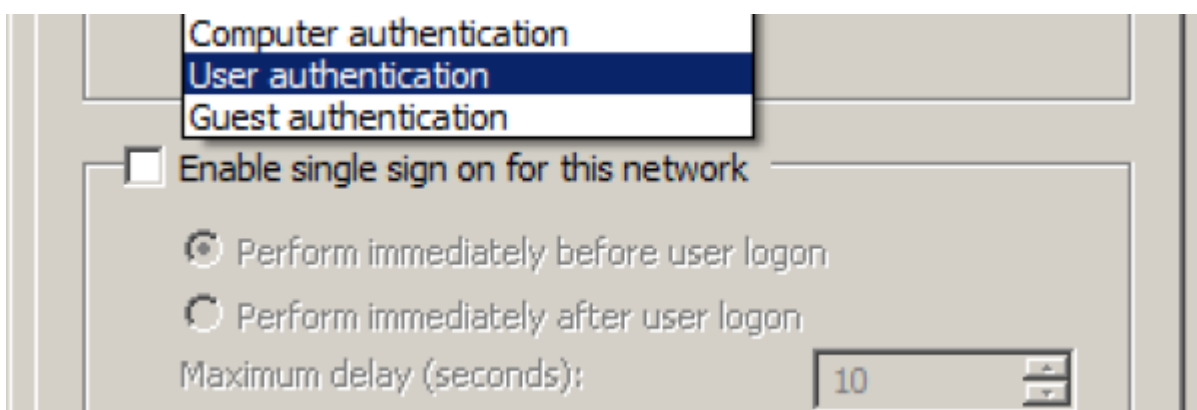
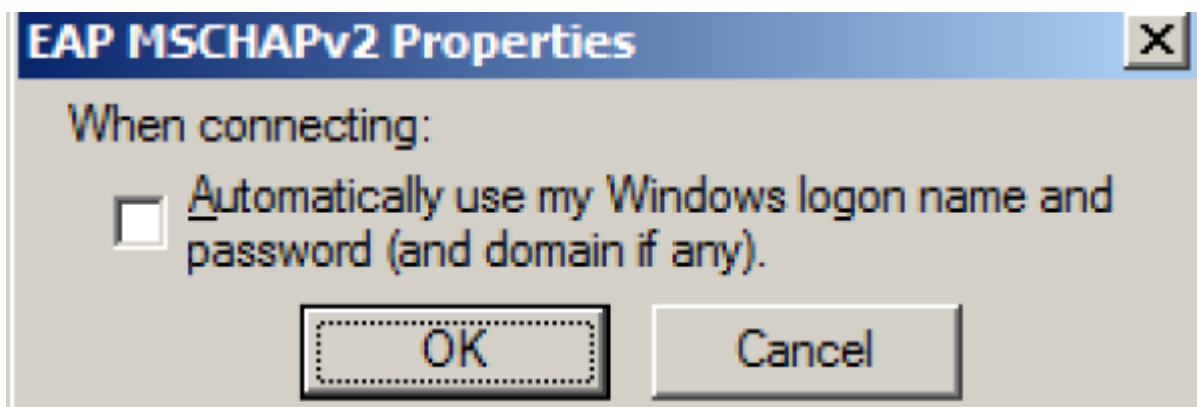
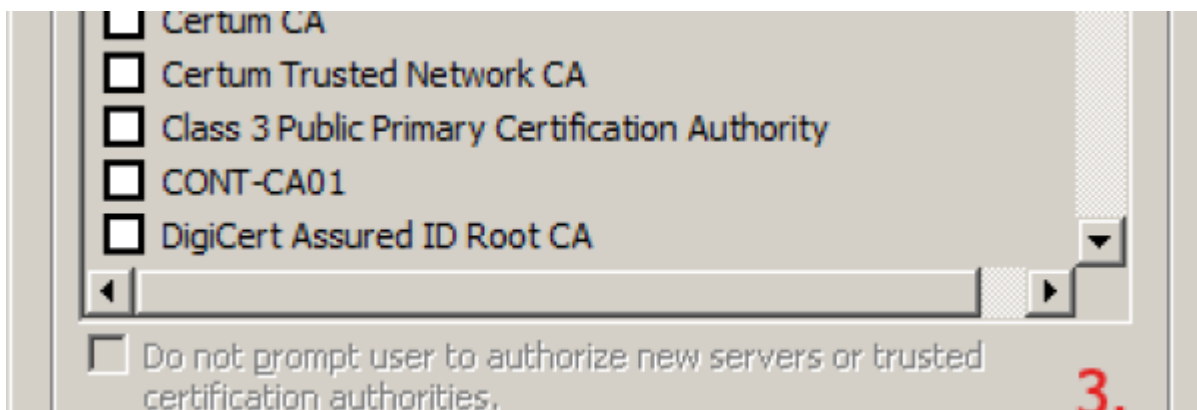
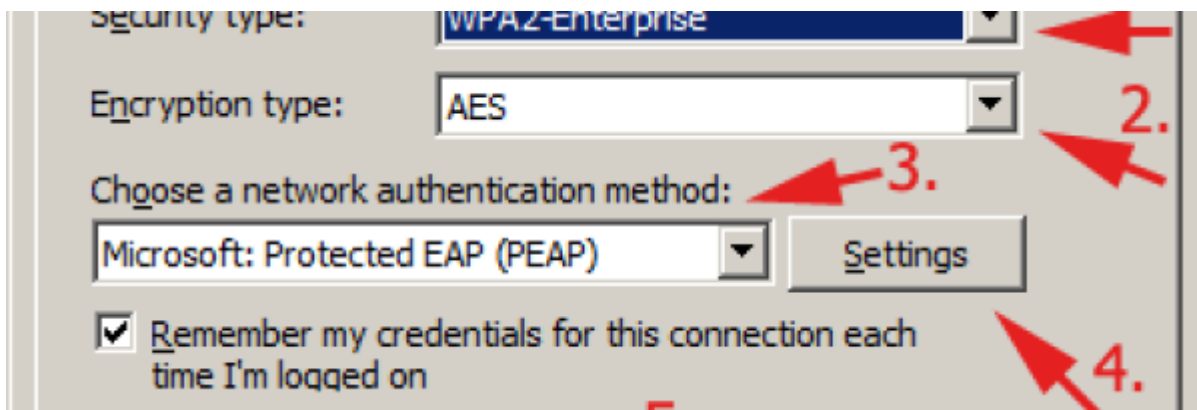


WiFi 'residents' - Windows 7 Howto Guide

Following screenshots will guide you through WiFi setting in Windows 7. Other versions of Windows should work almost the same.









Replace credentials

Saving your credentials allows your computer to connect to the network when you're not logged on (for example, to download updates).
