

How to add Kyocera printer on Mac

First thing to do is to contact IT Helpdesk. We have to know your **login username** of your Mac in order to add your account into kyocera server.

After that, you go into your settings → Printers → Add printer


Address - myq.cerge-ei.cz

Protocol - Line Printer Daemon "LPD"

Queue - FM

Location - ***empty***

Use - Generic PCL printer
